Take the CG-2 towards Canillo-France Pass the town of Canillo and at kilometre 14, turn left at the roundabout towards Ransol. Follow CS-260 until you reach Ransol. At the crossroads, turn right, in the direction of La Coma de Ransol. After 2 kilometres, turn right and head towards Entor. Follow this road until the tarmac ends, at which point you'll find a signpost indicating the start of the route.


The road climbs eastward for 300 metres among a forest made up of mountain pines, until it reaches a crossroad.
