BEHIND THE NAME

A simple, short walk around the Vilars, one of the villages in the parish of Escaldes-Engordany. The route allows you to explore some old buildings, such as typical mountain bordes or manor houses, which are today the main homes of the inhabitants of Escaldes.

The cobbled path takes you to Sant Romà dels Vilars church, a tiny pre-Romanesque building built in the 10th century, austere and very simple architecturally speaking. This church is one of the oldest in the Principality of Andorra. It was built using unworked stone blocks and distributed horizontally.

It has a rectangular floor plan with the apse facing east, as is the case with all Christian churches. The apse is square and to the south of the building is a very rough door and a small window that seem to have been added at a later date. The orchards, fields and valley floor accompany you along the entire route.

As for the most common fauna, you find common wood pigeon (Columba palumbus), a large species of general grey colour, with a white spot on the sides of the neck and the edges of the wings, and a tail ending with a black stripe.

Go uphill along the cobbled path of Els Vilars, the first section of which is marked by a steep slope before reaching Sant Romà dels Vilars church. This church is listed as one of the oldest in the Principality of Andorra.
