Notice of 12/08/2026 regarding road closures for the route of the 4th stage of La Vuelta Ciclista a España 2026.

Due to the passage through the Principality of Andorra of the 4th stage of La Vuelta Ciclista a España 2026, various measures have been adopted that will affect road traffic on Tuesday 25 August.

Tuesday 25 August: the entire stage takes place within the country, with the start and finish in Andorra la Vella.

As the riders' pass through, traffic will be interrupted on each of the following road sections:

- Start from Avinguda de Tarragona in Andorra la Vella, heading north.
- Climb up the CG-2 via the Encamp and Canillo bypass and over the Envalira pass.
- Descent on the CG-2, southbound, via the Envalira Tunnel to Encamp.
- Climb up the Beixalís pass and descent through Aldosa, towards Ordino.
- Climb up the Ordino pass and descent through Montaup to Canillo.
- Descent on the CG-2 to Engolasters, climb up to La Plana and descent through La Comella.
- Arrival and finish on Avinguda de Tarragona in Andorra la Vella.

The estimated passing times for the leading riders are:

- 14.40: Start from Avinguda de Tarragona, Andorra la Vella
- 14.51: Encamp
- 15.05: Canillo
- 15.39: Port d'Envalira summit
- 15.43: El Pas de la Casa
- 16.00: Canillo
- 16.05: Encamp
- 16.25: Coll de Beixalís summit
- 16.32: l'Aldosa
- 16.35: Ordino
- 16.59: Coll d'Ordino summit
- 17.08: Canillo
- 17.12: Encamp
- 17.25: La Comella pass summit
- 17.30: Arrival and finish on Avinguda de Tarragona, Andorra la Vella

Roads will be closed approximately one hour before the riders' scheduled times, starting from when the Police Service vehicle passes waving red flags, and will reopen after the Police Service vehicle passes waving green flags.

Considering the route passes through the section of the CG-2 between Encamp and Canillo, this section will be closed for approximately **3 hours**.

Due to logistical requirements for setting up the start and finish infrastructure, Avinguda de Tarragona in Andorra la Vella will be closed between the La Comella roundabout and the km 0 roundabout for approximately **24 hours**, from 10 p.m. on Monday 24 August to 10 p.m. on Tuesday 25 August. However, affected residents will be able to enter and exit private car parking areas until 1 p.m. on the day of the stage.

From 12 noon, the publicity caravan will follow an alternative route to that of the riders, before they pass, as detailed below:

Departure from Avinguda Tarragona in Andorra la Vella, then along the CG-2 road, through Encamp (via the town centre), Canillo, Pas de la Casa, the Coll d'Ordino mountain pass, Ordino, La Massana, the Sant Antoni tunnels, Avinguda Fiter i Rossell, Avinguda Dr. Mitjavila, Avinguda Meritxell, Avinguda Príncep Benlloch, Santa Coloma, Sant Julià de Lòria, and finally the Runer River border crossing.

Despite these suggested timetables, depending on how the race pans out, the police will close the roads and take the appropriate measures to ensure safety.

The communes of the affected parishes will take the appropriate measures regarding vehicle parking on the aforementioned stretches between Monday 24 and Tuesday 25 August.

General recommendations

- On Tuesday 25 August, avoid travelling by car from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m.
- Plan your journeys in advance.
- Check traffic conditions via the Mobilitat Andorra app or website.
- Use public transport wherever possible.

On 24 and 25 August, the open-air car parks of Parc Central, Centre Ciutat and Prada Guillemó in Andorra la Vella will not be operational, due to the space required for setting up the stage start and finish infrastructure and for the parking of vehicles belonging to the groups accompanying the race.

Pursuant to Article 16 of Law 16/2017 of 13 July on tourism accommodation, the prohibition on overnight stays and camping outside campsites, camping areas, motorhome parking areas and motorhome reception areas in motorhomes, caravans, campervans, or any type of van modified for travelling and accommodation is hereby suspended for the duration of this event, as provided for in Decree 286/2026 of 22 July 2026.
