## BEHIND THE NAME

Coll dels Isards: Descriptive name formed from the common name chamois (isard) in the plural and motivated by the frequent passage o these animals.

The Pics d'Envalira are a ridge of four peaks that form the border between Andorra and France. Not far from Portella Blanca is the meeting point between France, Andorra and Spain.

The north face seen from Pas de la Casa is vertical and steep, while the south side has softer slopes and grass.

Pic d'Envalira (2,827 metres) is the highest, at just a few metres higher than the star of this route, Pic Negre d'Envalira ( 2,816 metres). On a lot of maps, the heights have been confused due to their proximity and the small difference between them.

The Ruta del Pic Negre d'Envalira is a high-mountain hike in the parish of Encamp, in the north-east of the Principality of Andorra. The route is average difficulty, starting at a considerable altitude (2120 metres), in the last Andorran village before you get to France.

Although the hike goes through high-mountain terrain, it doesn't present any technical difficulties. Once on the Coll dels Isards and up to the summit, you'll be able to enjoy spectacular $360^{\circ}$ panoramic views.
